Delicate Strength — New Reinforced Armature Techniques for Jewelry

In this class we will survey the exciting array of delicate, yet strong, jewelry forms achieved through this innovative technique. Through the use of fabrication, sculpting, layering, and multi-cycle curing we will create a variety of delicate pieces for use as earrings, brooches, or pendants or whatever else you might imagine. The focus of the workshop is on construction methods; but students will also explore surface ornamentation, finishing and joining multiple forms. This is a technique workshop, not a project class, therefore all students need a basic working knowledge of polymer clay.
